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Задание 2

(УЧАСТИЕ В УСЛОВНОМ ДИАЛОГЕ-РАСПРОСЕ)

Экзаменуемому требуется ответить на шесть вопросов условного телефонного опроса на определенную тему (согласно примерной тематике спецификации КИМ ОГЭ). При этом экзаменуемый не видит на экране вопроса, а только слышит его в аудиозаписи.

Временной регламент

- Время ответа на каждый вопрос – 40 секунд

Что проверяется:

Умения диалогической речи:

- Сообщать информацию, отвечая на вопросы разных видов.
- Выражать свое мнение/отношение.
- Аргументировать ответ, если требуется.
- Давать интервью.
- Точно и правильно употреблять языковые средства оформления диалогического высказывания.

Что оценивается:

- Коммуникативная составляющая ответа.
- Допускаются лексические и фонетические погрешности, не затрудняющие восприятия.

Критерии оценивания:

Максимум за задание – 6 баллов

Оценивается отдельно каждый из шести ответов.

Технология выполнения задания на экзамене:

- Внимательно прослушайте задание, попытайтесь услышать ключевые слова, понять смысл, определить грамматическую структуру и тип вопроса.
- Можно проговорить вопрос про себя еще раз.
- Не торопитесь отвечать сразу, подумайте несколько секунд, так как у вас есть 40 секунд для ответа на каждый вопрос.
- Надо помнить, что краткий ответ на общий вопрос требует употребления вспомогательного глагола.
- Если вы сначала дали краткий ответ, далее обязательно должен следовать полный ответ.
- Ответ должен быть дан полным предложением (предложениями).
- Ответ должен быть на конкретно поставленный вопрос, не нужно делать обобщенных вступительных фраз или уходить от темы.

5. Do you prefer using libraries or internet resources?
6. Do you think e-books will replace printed books in future?

на максимальный балл (6 баллов)**

- 1) How old are you?
I'm 15 years old.
- 2) Do you like reading? Why? / Why not?
Personally, I like reading. I think that books educate people in different

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spheres of life and make us more intelligent. Moreover, some books can make our life more interesting and help us entertain and relax.

3) Why do people need libraries?

People need libraries for some reasons, I think. Firstly, they can use memoirs, atlases, encyclopaedias to write their articles or other types of works. Secondly, there are also rare books and they can use them as well for their studying and work. Finally, meetings with authors are held in some libraries, so you can attend them. It can be useful for you too.

4) Do you use your school library?

Yes, I do. I use my school library sometimes. It's very convenient for doing project works or writing articles on different subjects. Moreover, I can borrow books and encyclopaedias for my literature classes and be ready to write compositions.

5) Do you prefer using libraries or internet resources?

As for me, I prefer internet resources. Firstly, it saves my time — as I can easily and quickly find the necessary information. Secondly, I don't need to go to the library, I stay at home and can use the Internet any time I wish. Thus, it's convenient.

Jupiter is the largest planet in the Solar System with a diameter of 142 984 kilometres. This is 11 times bigger than the diameter of the Earth. It is the fifth planet from the Sun. Jupiter is called a gas giant, as it is large and made up of gas. The other gas giants are Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune.

Jupiter can be seen with the naked eye. It was known to the ancient Romans, who named it after their god Jupiter. Jupiter is the third brightest object in the night sky. Only the Earth's moon and Venus are brighter.

Jupiter is twice as massive as all the other planets in the Solar System put together. It gives off more heat than it gets from the Sun. Jupiter is 11 times the width of the Earth and 318 times as massive.

Jupiter has a thin planetary ring system. These rings are difficult to see and were not discovered until 1979 by NASA's Voyager 1 probe.

Комментарий

В этом письме 130 слов. Есть превышение заданного объема, но письмо будет проверено полностью.

Задание выполнено полностью. РКЗ оценивается в 3 балла.

Организация оценивается в 1 балл, так как текст в основном логично выстроен, но имеется 1 недостаток при использовании средств логической связи, а именно при переходе к заключению: Oh, I should go. Следует использовать другой переход: That's all for now. Недостаточно использованы слова-связки внутри абзацев.

Лексико-грамматическое оформление текста оценивается в 2 балла, так как допущены 3 ошибки:

- 1) Them, I should go to bed *till* one o'clock, — следует написать так: Them, I should go to bed *before* one o'clock.
- 2) Besides, I allowed to watch TV...— следует написать так: Besides, I *am* allowed to watch TV...
- 3) I use TV *for* a background sound. — следует написать так: I use TV *as* a background sound.

Орфография и пунктуация оценивается в 1 балл, так как допущены 3 ошибки:

- 1) *My parients*... Правильно: My parents...
- 2) *Them, I should*... Правильно: Then, I should...
- 3) *My parients know, I can't watch* TV for a long time. — Запятая перед придаточным предложением не ставится.

Комментарий

Решение коммуникативной задачи. Один аспект раскрыт не полностью. Третий вопрос не соответствует тематике, этот вопрос не о друзьях, а об отношении к ним. Нет ссылки на предыдущий контакт.

Организация оценена в 2 балла.

Языковое оформление –1 балл, допущены 4 ошибки.

Комментарий

В заключении следует подтвердить свою точку зрения, а не указывать другую. В этом эссе РКЗ оценивается в 1 балл, так как один аспект не раскрыт.

Эссе № 4. Неточное выражение противоположной точки зрения

Тема: **People achieve great results if they are satisfied with their job**

Work is an essential part of people's life. Some people believe that satisfaction with their job leads to success. Others argue that they can achieve a lot without feeling satisfied with their job.

In my opinion, everybody wants work to bring pleasure and success. Firstly, fulfillment of particular tasks and the feeling of satisfaction stimulates workers to obtain a new target and then reach the goal. Secondly, a favourite job makes people initiative and motivated, so they become interested in getting good results and do their best at work.

On the other hand, some people consider gratification with the job to be not so important. They think that diligence and pursuit of excellence make more sense. What is more, a person who is sincerely pleased with his job, but unskilled and unqualified is unlikely to show great results.

Personally, I disagree with the opponents' point of view. I think people are driven by the desire for perfection. If people really like their job, they learn and practice a lot to become highly qualified professionals.

To sum up, there are two reasonable points of view. I strongly believe that people who are passionate about their job do their best to achieve great results.

Комментарий

В этом эссе 202 слова. Другая точка зрения (3 абзац) высказана неточно и неполно. Далее идет нарушение логики: «They think that diligence and pursuit of excellence make more sense.» Следует написать так: «They think it is the results that make sense.» Предложение: «What is more, a person who is sincerely pleased with his job, but unskilled and unqualified is unlikely to show great results.» тоже нарушает логику. Следует написать так: «They strive for success at any cost, sometimes at the cost of their health, as they have to work longer and harder if they are unskilled and unqualified.»

Так как третий и четвертый абзацы связаны между собой, то придется исправлять и контраргумент: «If people really like their job, they learn and practice a lot to become highly qualified professionals.» Таким образом, следует написать так: «If people really like their job, it will not be a burden for them to practice a lot to become highly qualified professionals.»

РКЗ в этом эссе будет оценено в 2 балла, так как два аспекта раскрыты не полностью или неточно. Организация текста будет оценена в 1 балл, так как имеются три логические ошибки.

В 2018 году были уточнены критерии оценивания заданий с развернутым ответом, в том числе и Задания №40. Была также уточнена типология стилистических ошибок. **Выделены 4 типа стилистических ошибок:**

- 1) риторические вопросы
- 2) разговорные выражения и конструкции типа Let's... (Let us и Let me все же считаем как нейтральный стиль)
- 3) сниженную лексику типа folks (people)...
- 4) три варианта стяженных форм:
 - типа I'm, he's...
 - отрицательные формы типа don't, aren't...
 - формы модальных глаголов типа can't, I'd like...

Если допущено одно нарушение нейтрального стиля любого типа, ставится + по данному аспекту, если больше, но не во всех типах, то ставится + –, если есть нарушения во всех четырех типах, то считаем данный аспект 6 по **РКЗ** не состоявшимся и ставим –.

Эссе № 5. Нарушения нейтрального стиля

Тема: **People achieve great results if they are satisfied with their job**

The problem of choosing the future career is very urgent nowadays. Some people believe that people become successful at work if *they're* pleased with their job. However, there are others who claim that *revel doesn't* affect the job success.

In my opinion, it is better to choose job that you love. Firstly, it gives no satisfaction to work on unlikeable job. People who work on such jobs are more oftenly affected by stress. Secondly, if get engaged in the work *you're cut out for*, the *work'll* be much easier for you. The job should be like a hobby.

On the other hand, some people say that job must be chosen according to material aspect of the profession. It is common knowledge that good salary gives opportunity to satisfy all person's needs.

I totally disagree with the statement above, because there are people for whom the job satisfaction is more important than high salary. Undoubtedly, the financial aspect is very important but it has no sense if *you'll* live your life *as a bored, exhausted slug*.

In conclusion, there are two points of view on the problem. I suppose that the job must be not only well-paid, but satisfying. However, other people should decide for themselves to live rich and prosperous yet unhappy life or *to have a gas*.
