Ostankino Palace Museum of Serf Art

Developed and decorated for over four centuries, Ostankino is a famous Moscow site. The museum is [32] _____ for its collection of seventeenth- and eighteenth-century paintings, engravings, crystal and porcelain.

For Count Sheremetiev this estate, like the Taj Mahal, was the labour of love that reflected his two great [33] _____: his wife Praskovia Zhemchugova, and his theatre. When Praskovia died in childbirth, the count [34] _____ the palace and his theatre.

Sheremetiev treated his staff of serf-actors with affection and respect. Each of his star singers and dancers developed his or her talent under the guidance of Western teachers, [35] _____ did his architects and craftsmen.

The first plans for Ostankino Palace, which was to [36] _____ as a summer residence and a theatre, were submitted by the famous architect Quarenghi in 1794. Yet they were not [37] _____ to the count's expectations, so he turned the project over to his own serf-architect — Fedor Argunov. Under his direction the palace grew into a building which combined the dignity of an urban residence with the ease of a country villa. This is one of the best examples of Russian Classical Style. The palace is made of wood, but its exterior resembles stone. The bright colour scheme of the halls, imaginatively designed parquet floor, and elaborate use of carved wood introduce the typical [38] _____ of Russian art in this Western-style mansion.
